This 55 Acre Oasis will filled with blooming Magnolias, Rhododendrons, Japanese Cherries, Pacific Dog-wood, and Camellias, plus offers two wonderful onsite dining choices, Trillium Cafe and Shaughnessy Restaurant. Just a hop and skip away is Queen Elizabeth Park and the Bloedel Conservatory, an indoor tropical garden complete with exotic birds and Koi fish, atop the highest point of the city. Check into your hotel for an overnight stay. In the morning, we board our ferry to Vancouver Island, where more garden delights will be waiting for us to explore at Butchart Gardens.
